Our offerings for Women

- Free training in sewing, embroidery, and cloth painting in our sewing centers.
- Assistance in getting a sewing machine.
- Freedom from dependence on day labor in seasonal crop harvesting, for instance, picking and sorting chili peppers, cotton, or tobacco.
- Improving their standard of living by working at home or in a tailor shop.
- Contributing to subsistence and improving their standing in the family and society.
- Better opportunities for educating their children so that they may have improved career chances.
- Medical care and medicine through our medical centers.



Our Sewing Centers

- We now have many sewing centers in Andhra Pradesh.
- They can handle up to ten students each course.
- Almost 2000 women have so far gotten a solid, basic foundation.
- The native instructors are employed by Shoshana.
